▼ **Roca**

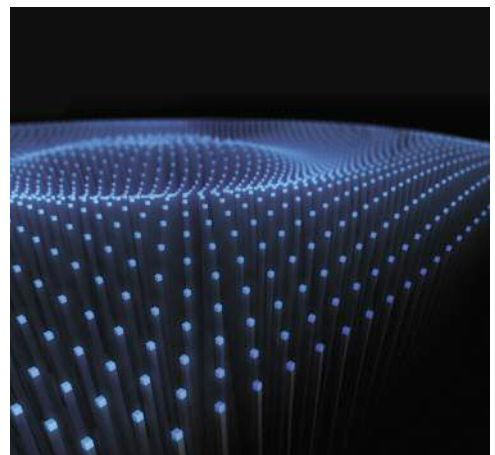
